
With the laptop closed, clean the top with the provided alcohol wipe and allow it to dry completely.



Clean the fixture surface where the laptop will be displayed. Allow it to dry completely.




Be sure you can identify the 2 different halves of the unit. The **ALARM** side can be identified by it's larger size, it also has the IR lens and the sound port on it. The **ANCHOR** side is smaller and almost completely smooth. While installing be sure to interact with the appropriate side.







If the laptop being displayed has a curved back, remove the adhesive from the alarm side of the unit.




Clean the alarm side of the unit with the provided alcohol wipe. Allow it to dry completely.



Remove one of the Curved Surface Adhesives (ADH2175) from it's backing.



Place the Curved Surface Adhesive onto the alarm side. Apply pressure for at least 10 seconds.







Peel the clear film from the adhesive on the bottom of the alarm side.




Determine where the alarm will be placed. Make sure that the cable will not be pinched when the laptop is opened.






Place the alarm side onto the back of the laptop. The alarm can be placed as to not cover the logo if desired. Apply pressure for at least 10 seconds.






To stud mount (DNWX91 for thinner fixtures, DGD403 for thicker fixtures) the anchor to the fixture. Thread the stud into the bottom of the anchor side of the unit.






Be sure the plunger will sit against the surface and will not sit in the hole. Adjust the anchor if necessary before









Peel the clear film from the adhesive on the anchor side of the unit.





9 If a stud mount kit was used, place the anchor side of the unit over the hole so that the stud fits through the fixture, with the cable facing any direction except TOWARDS the laptop. Place the washer and wingnut over the stud and fully tighten by hand.





Place the anchor unit on the surface with the cable facing **any direction except TOWARDS** the laptop. Apply pressure for at least 10 seconds.













## 4 Replacing the Battery:

Begin by removing the adhesive from the alarm side of the unit.









Remove the old battery.




Install the new battery ( standard CR2450 or InVue's EM4421).




Reattach the battery door with the 4 screws. Make sure the screws are fully seated but do NOT overtighten.








Remove the replacement adhesive (ADH2174 - Sensor replacement PSA) from the backing and place on the bottom of the alarm side. Apply pressure for at least 10 seconds.




To replace the adhesive on the anchor side, first remove the old adhesive.




